<b>Postmark Date</b>	May 1 through June 5, 2010. <b>NO REFUNDS after after June 19, 2010.</b>
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<b>\$180 (Juniors fee: same but each state may subsidize fee.)</b> Fee includes entry fee, practice round, cart use for all tournament play* - even if a player decides to walk, range balls, tee gifts, prizes**, and competitor's barbeque on 7/7/10 following play – available from 12:00 noon until all players finish play.
<b>Practice Round</b>	Anytime after June 15 <sup>th</sup> . Call Pro Shop (802) 422-4635 for a tee time.
<b>Handicap Limit</b>	<b>Handicap Index Limit: 17.4 Revision Date for waitlist: 6/5/10.</b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	A contestant may be any amateur woman with a USGA handicap index of 17.4 or less, and must be an active member of one of the New England Women's Golf Association's member state associations. A Junior is any girl who is a resident of the respective state and has not reached her 19 <sup>th</sup> birthday by the opening day of the tournament. A Junior of 18 years of age is eligible to play only if she has not yet begun her first semester of college. A Junior does not have to be a member of a NEWGA member state association, but must have a USGA handicap index of 17.4 or below. <b>Parents or guardians are NOT allowed to caddie for juniors.</b> Seniors must be 50 years old and Legends must be 65 years old by the opening day of the tournament.
<b>Tournament Information</b>	Each state has a quota of 18 players. The total field will be 108 players for 36 holes and then cut to the top 70 (low score) players including ties for the final round of play including any player within ten shots of the leader in player's respective age category. The wait list for greater than 18 applicants from a state is created by handicap index for each state after all states have entered their player lists. If a state is unable to fill its allotted positions, the unused positions will be divided equally among the states that have a waiting list.

**Legend:** 65 and older; **Senior:** 50 and older; **Junior:** 18 and under

**\*New:** Carts are included in the entry fee for all tournament play even if the players walks or uses a pull cart (course is very hilly). Players will pay cart fee of \$20 for practice round. Caddie fee for the practice round is \$40 plus the \$20 cart fee. Caddie cart fee will be assessed if the caddie rides in cart during the tournament .

**\*\*New Prize Structure:** Top 20 gross and 3 daily net prizes – Universal Pro Shop Awards Certificates will be awarded that may be used at any of the New England Pro Shops. These must be redeemed by 10/1/10.

The use of distance measuring devices will be allowed during this Championship by local rule.
