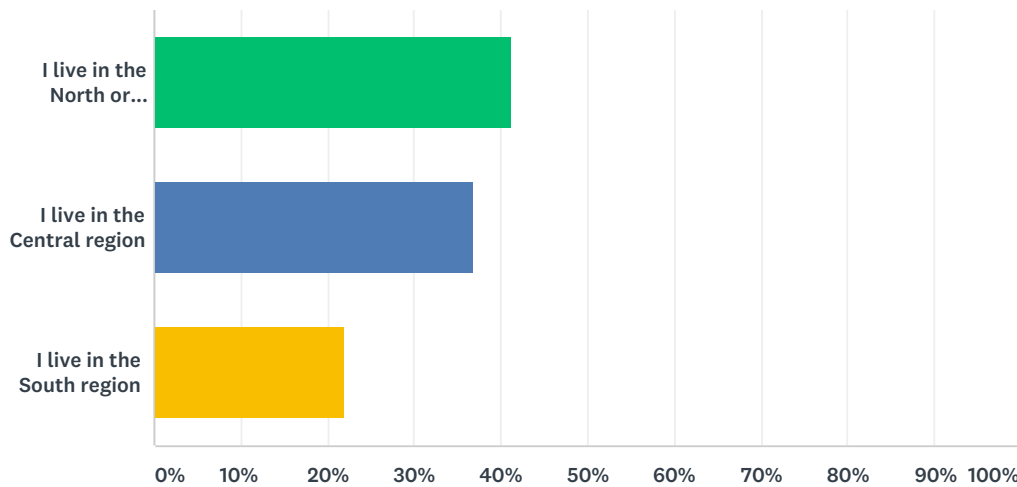

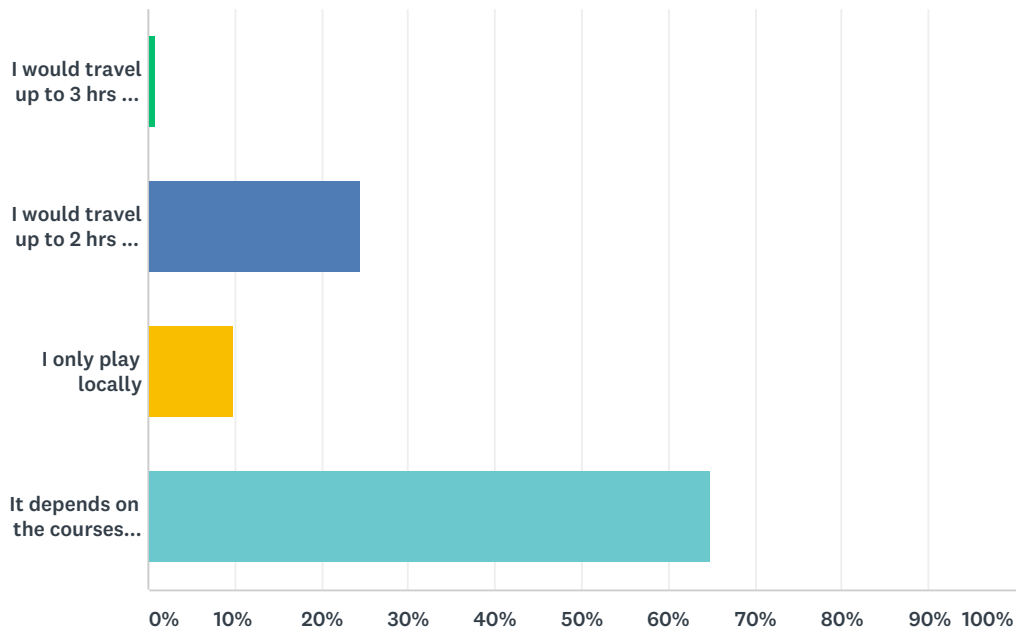

Q2 How important is travel time in your decision to play? (Choose only 1 answer)

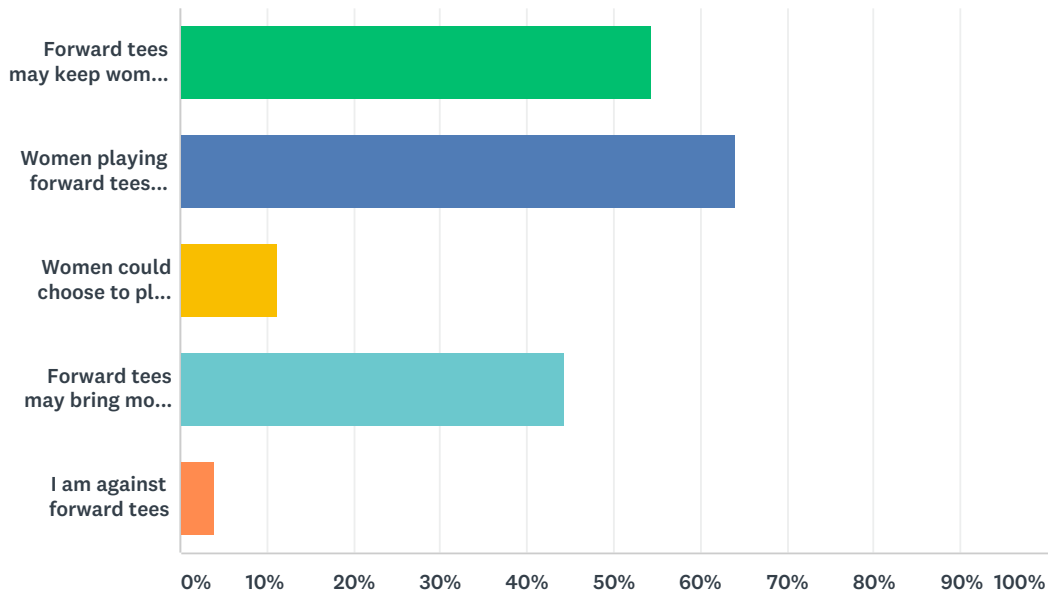

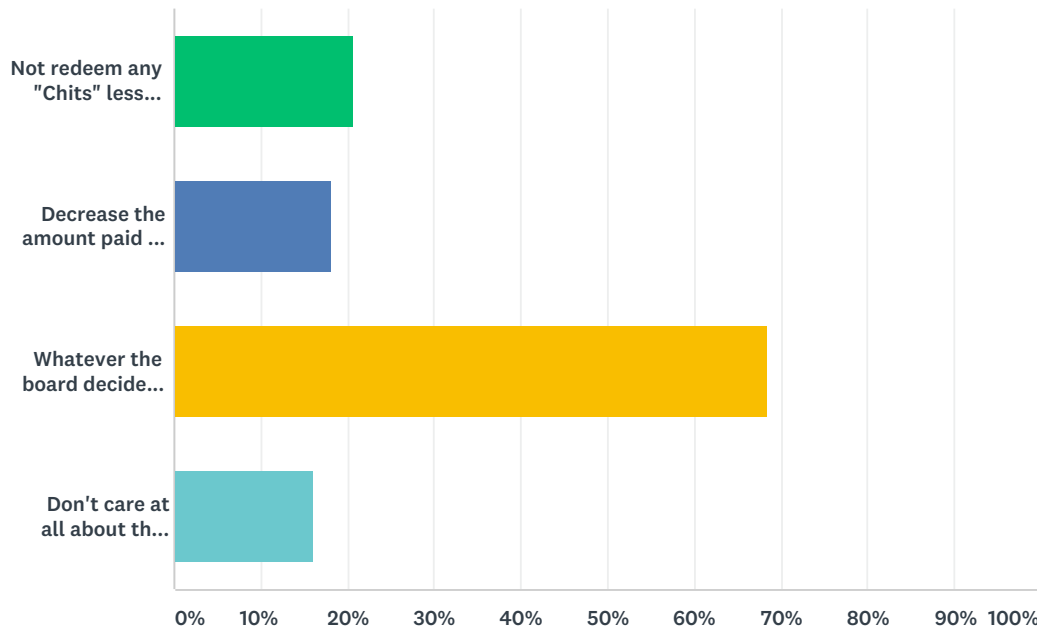

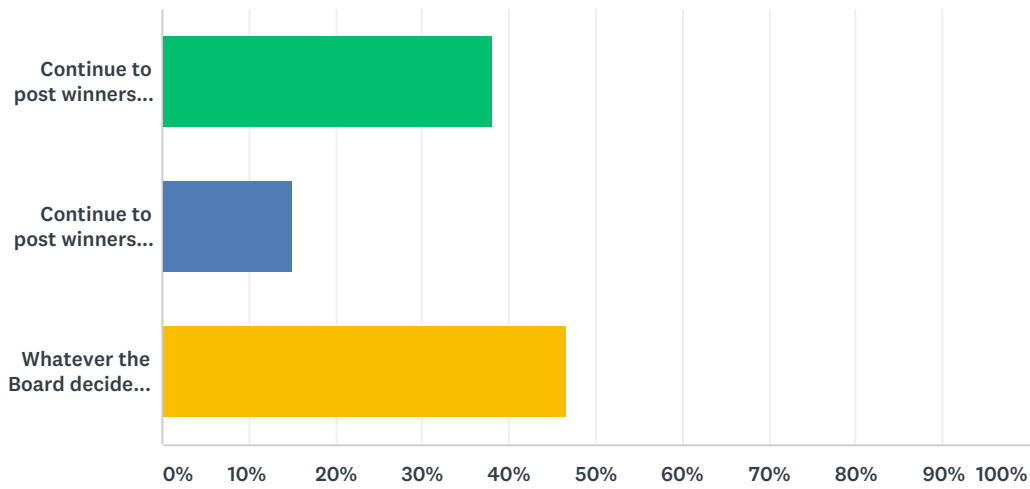

Q5 Currently, the Closest To The Pin winners are posted for each course and the "Chit" is sent out weekly or biweekly. (choose only 1)

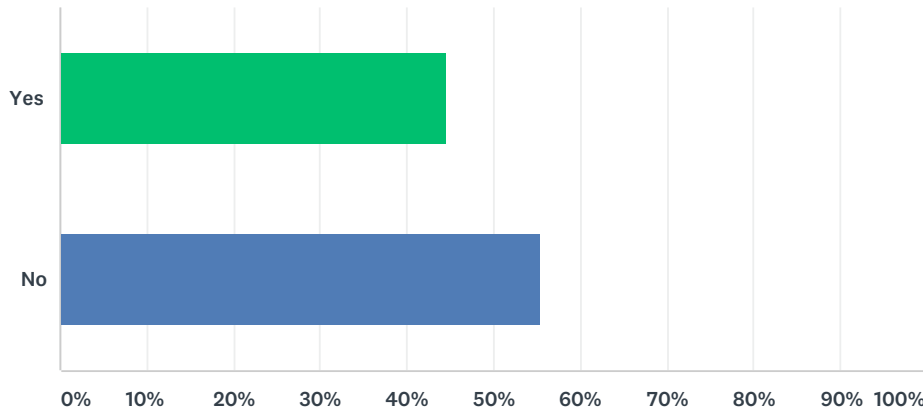

Q6 Do you own a 2017 or 2018 USGA Rule Book?

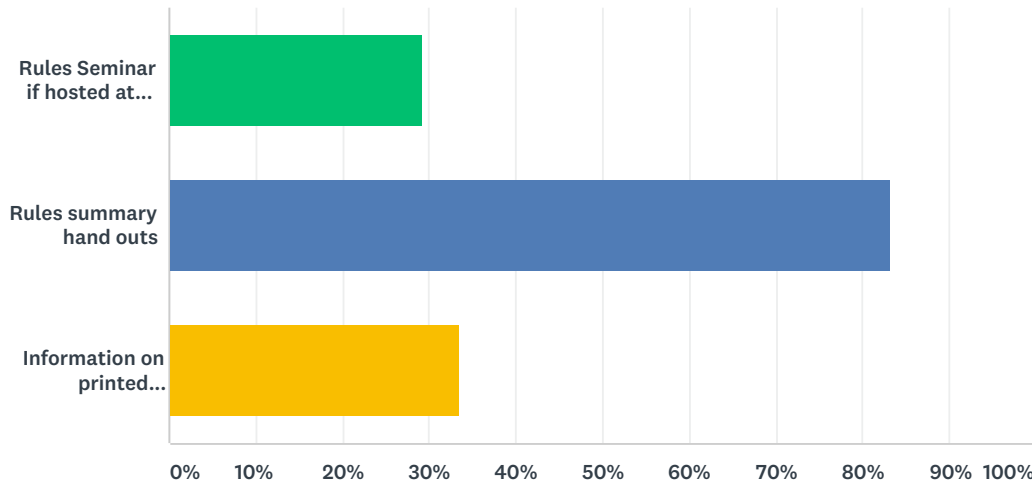

Q7 2019 will have many rules changes that impact general play. How would you like to receive information on the rules changes? (choose all that apply)

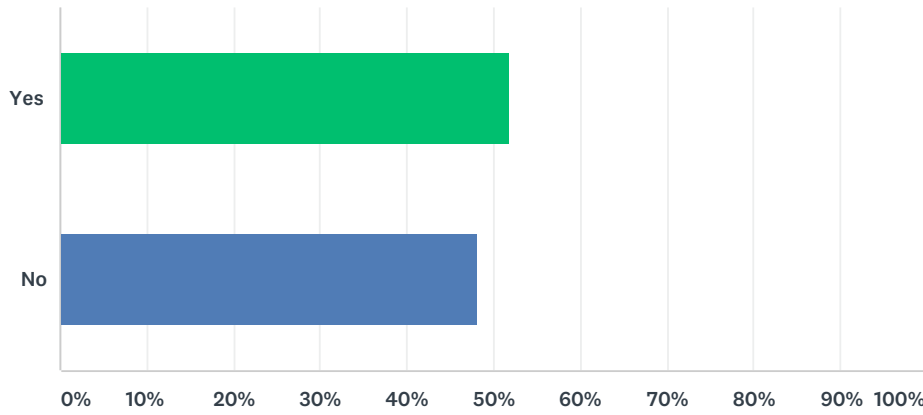

Q8 If the VSWGGA Facebook page was restarted would you look at it?

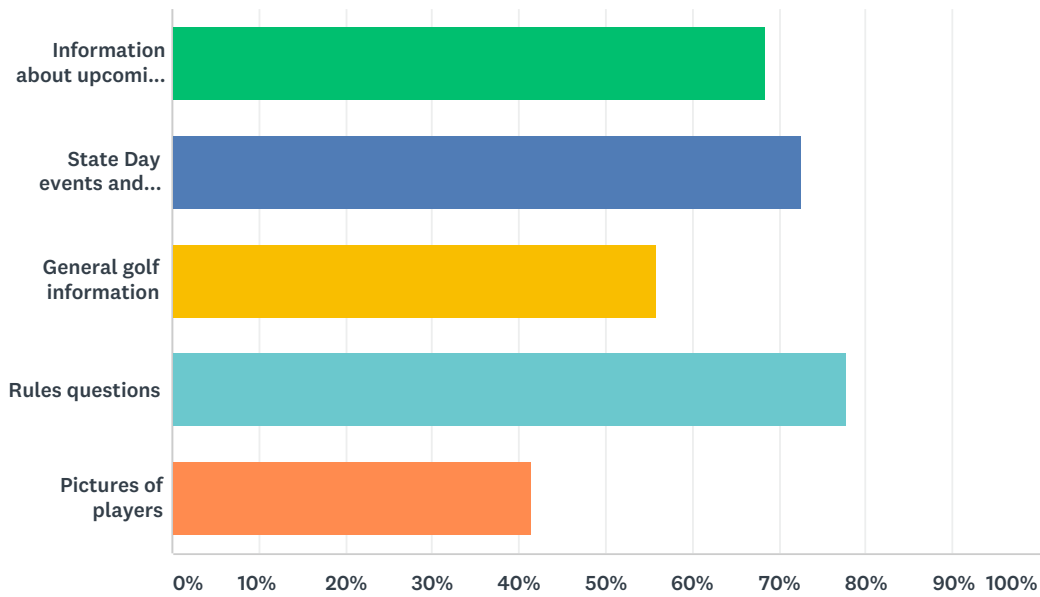
